

# Art Vocabulary - Vebijêrk Hunerê

## Analogous colours

Rengan

groups of colours that are next to each other on the colour wheel

## Background

Paşde

the part of an artwork that is far away

## Blending

Blending

mixing from light to dark

## Blurring details

holêrabûna hûragahiyân

making small things have less detail so they seem far away

## Brainstorming

Brainstorming

coming up with a large number of ideas

## Brushstroke

Brushstroke

the mark made by the bristles of a brush in painting

## Central composition

kompozîsyona central

an arrangement where the most important thing is in the middle

## Colour composition

kompozîsyona color

the arrangement of colours in an artwork

## Colour scheme

Schema rengê

the choice of colours in an artwork

## Colour mixing

Rengê rengîn

adding two or more colours together

## Colour wheel

Rengê rengê

a circle of coloured sections that shows the relationships between colours

## Complementary colours

Rengên pêkanîn

colours that are opposites on the colour wheel

## Composition

Têkilî

the arrangement of things in an artwork

## Contour drawing

Qirêjê

drawing the edges and outlines

## Contrast

Contrast

the difference between the lights and darks

## Cool colours

Rengên cool

colours that are calm and soothing, such as blues and greens

## Creativity

Afirînerî

ideas that are useful, unique, and insightful

## Cropping

Bikin

cutting off part of a picture

**Cross-hatching**

Cross-hatching

drawing using close parallel lines that cross each other at an angle

**Cyan**

Cyan

a greenish-blue colour that is one of the colour primaries

**Decreasing contrast**

Pevçûnê kêmbike

making the range between the lights and darks smaller so that things look muddier and far away

**Depth**

Depth

the sense that some things are near and others are far away

**Detail**

Detail

small, important parts of a drawing

**Dry brush painting**

Paqijkirina paqij

creating scratchy brushstrokes using a brush that is mostly dry

**Dull colours**

Rengên xurt

colours that are weak, and not very vivid

**Foreground**

Pêşeroj

the part of an artwork that is biggest and closest

**Hatching**

Hatching

drawing using close parallel lines

**Idea development**

Pêşketina Idea

a process that is used to create useful, insightful, and unique ideas

**Increasing contrast**

Berevajî zêdekirina

making the range between the lights and darks bigger so that things look more intense and close up

**Insightful**

Çavkanî

something that shows deep thinking

**Intense colours**

Rengên giran

colours that are strong and very vivid

**Magenta**

magenta

a reddish purple (hot pink) that is one of the colour primaries

**Modelling**

Modeling

making things 3D using blending

**Negative space**

Qada Negative

the shape of the space between the things you would normally look at (the positive space)

**Non-central composition**

Komîteya ne-navendî

an arrangement where the most important thing is NOT in the middle

**Positive space**

Cihêkî erênî

the contour of the things you would normally look at

**Primary colour**

Rengê sereke

a colour that cannot be mixed using other colours: cyan, yellow, and magenta

**Reference images**

Wêneyên referans

photographs used to look at so you can make a better artwork

**Rotating**

Rotating

turning a picture to a new angle

**Secondary colour**

Rengê duyemîn

a colour that is created by mixing two primary colours: red, green, and blue

**Shading**

Shading

drawing with white, black, and greys

**Sharpening details**

Agahdariyên agahdariyê

making small things have more detail so they seem close up

**Smoothness**

Smoothness

drawing cleanly, with no bumps

**Split complement colour scheme**

Vebijêrîna rengê tevahiya rengê

a colour scheme using one base colour, and two colours on either side of the complementary

**Square colour scheme**

Schema rengê qada

a colour scheme in which colours are balanced around the colour wheel in the shape of a square

**Stippling**

Stippling

drawing using small dots

**Texture**

Texture

drawing that looks the same as what it feels like

**Thumbnail drawings**

Wêneyên wêneyan

small drawings that are used to develop the composition of an artwork

**Triad colour scheme**

Triad Color Scheme

a colour scheme in which colours are balanced around the colour wheel in the shape of a triangle

**Unique**

Unique

something that is rare, or one-of-a-kind

**Warm colours**

Rengên zerm

colours that are suggestive of heat or passion: yellows, oranges, and reds

**Web-mapping**

Web-mapping

linking together ideas into a web

**Wet-on-wet painting**

Wêneyek gilî ya gilê

adding paint to an already wet painting surface

**Zooming in/zooming out**

Zooming in / zooming out

making a picture seem closer (zoom in) or further away (zoom out)
